I am happy to enclose the updated information and materials regarding Coastal Community Credit Union's 2017 Scholarship Program. Coastal Community is committed to building healthier communities and supporting youth to be leaders by encouraging them make a meaningful difference in their communities and then rewarding them through scholarships to pursue post-secondary education. **Please note applications will only be accepted through our online application which can be found under our "In Our Communities" tab at cccu.ca.**

Again this year, we will be awarding 8 grade 12 students each with a \$2,000 scholarship. Of those 8 recipients 2 students will be awarded an additional amount up to \$1,000 to support the implementation their project plans and will receive an additional \$500 scholarship based on completion of their project. Awards will be selected based on quality of community project plan.

The Coastal Community Scholarship Program continues to be a great success. We have awarded 103 scholarships in nine years totaling almost \$364,000, and engaged hundreds of students in grades 12 within our Vancouver Island and Gulf Island Communities.

Important Information:

- Applications will continue to be assessed based on project plans that address an environmental, social or economic need within and island community.
- For reference, a sample outline of a project plan is available on the Coastal Community website.
- Students are eligible even if they have participated in another national or international scholarship program.
- Applications must be received no later than **April 1st, 2018**, and any applications received after this date will not be considered.

We appreciate you making available our information sheets to your grade 12 students. Information is also available on website at cccu.ca.

We welcome the opportunity to visit your school and speak to students about this program, as well as answer questions students may have. Please contact me to schedule an information session or if you require additional materials or information.
